Think carefully as to which resource you use for the topic addressed. Obviously, some books will address some of the topics better than others. Choose the best of your examples.

- ✓Follow proper MLA formatting
- ✓Include a strong, descriptive topic sentence for each body paragraph
- ✓Use 2 properly integrated and cited quotes from the text in each body paragraph
- ✓Utilize proper transition wording between paragraphs
- ✓Write in 3rd person
- ✓Minimum of 5 body paragraphs
